

Grand Junction, Colo.  
August 23, 1921

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction was called to order at 4:00 o'clock P.M. with Mayor Cherrington presiding. The Commissioners present were Cherrington, Garber, Peck and Blackstone. City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved.

A petition signed by E.T. Wasso and others requesting that the fire limits be extended west on Main St. was presented and read. Moved by Commissioner Peck, second by Commissioner Garber that the petition be accepted and filed for future reference. Motion carried.

A proposed ordinance entitled "An ordinance levying a special assessment on certain real estate in Grand Junction, for benefits conferred by the water works of said city", was introduced and read. Moved by Commissioner Peck, second by Commissioner Blackstone, that the proposed ordinance be passed for publication. The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Garber, yea; Peck, yea; Blackstone, yea. All the Commissioners voting yea, the motion was declared carried.

Moved by Commissioner Peck, second by Commissioner Blackstone that the following bill be allowed.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Garber, yea; Blackstone, Yea; Peck, yea. All the Commissioners voting yea, the motion was declared carried and warrants drawn for the separate amounts.

Upon motion of Commissioner Peck, second by Commissioner Garber, the meeting adjourned.
