

Grand Junction, Colo.
November 22, 1921

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colo, met in regular session at 4:00 P.M. with Mayor Cherrington presiding. The Commissioners present were, Cherrington, Peck, Blackstone and Fonder. Commissioner Garber was absent. City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved.

A delegation from the vicinity of 5th and Teller met with the Council requesting the installation of an arc light at that corner. The committee was informed that the arc light was already ordered installed.

A communication from the Chamber of Commerce requesting the City Council to cooperate with the Chamber in a Clean up Day to be held November 28. Moved by Commissioner Cherrington, seconded by Commissioner Fonder that the communication be placed on file and that the Mayor and Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty meet with the members of the Chamber of Commerce to decide what course was to be taken in the clean-up campaign. Motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Blackstone, seconded by Commissioner Peck that John Colisimo be granted a permit to make one connection with the city sewer at 201 and 205 Hale Ave. on the receipt of \$40.00. The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows, Cherrington, yea; Peck, yea; Blackstone, yea, Fonder yea. All the Commissioners present voting yea, the motion was declared carried.
