

Grand Junction, Colo., Dec. 27, 1921

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session at 4:00 P.M.

Commissioners present were - Cherington, Peck, Garber, Fonder. Attorney Tupper was also present.

Moved by Peck, seconded by Garber that the petition of O. B. Trumbo and others for an arc light at the corner of 11th and Gunnison be referred to the incoming council.

Mrs. Emily B. Hardenburg and Miss Eunice Farnham applied for a permit to connect their properties located just east of the city limits and on the south side of Grande Avenue, with sewer in Sewer District No. 3.

Moved by Fonder seconded by Peck that they be given the right to connect their separate houses with sewer as above on payment of \$40.00 for each connection and giving the said parties the right to connect but one house each.

On Roll Call the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington Aye - Peck; Aye - Garber, Aye - Fonder, Aye.

All voting Aye, motion was declared carried.
