## MINUTES January 16, 1922

An adjourned meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met at 9:00 A.M. The Councilmen present were Hirons, Marshall Miller, Dowrey, Hampson and Murr. Councilman Meders was absent, having been excused. Acting City Manager Cherrington, City Manager Geo. Garrett, the City Attorney and the City Clerk were also present.

Mr. Garrett presented his bond for \$10,000.00 as City Manager of Grand Junction, the bond having been approved by the City Attorney. It was moved by Councilman Dowrey, seconded by Councilman Miller, that the bond be filed as approved. The motion carried.

George Garrett then took the oath of office as City Manager Fred A. Peck, Notary Public, administering the oath.

Mr. Sharer of the Grand Junction Town and Development Co. appeared before the Council asking for an extention of time in which he could take up tax sale certificates at the same terms given him by the old Council. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Hampson that Mr. Sharer be granted an extention of sixty days from January the First, 1922., rescinding action of meeting before. The motion carried.

Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Miller, that the City Attorney secure the abstract to the Cemetery Tracts. Motion carried.

It was suggested by the City Attorney that an audit be made of the City books up to the period ending January 15, 1922. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Dowrey that the audit as suggested be made. The motion carried.

There being no further business to transact, the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting was set for 7:30 P.M. January 23rd, 1922.
