MINUTES February 1, 1922

The City Councilmen of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session at 7:30 P.M. with President Hirons presiding. The Councilmen present were Hirons, Miller, Marshall, Dowrey, Meders, Hampson and Murr. City Attorney Jordan, City Clerk Fred Peck and City Treasurer Bunting were also present.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved.

A proposed ordinance entitled "An ordinance amending Section 1, Article 2, of Ordinance No. 83, passed and adopted June 30, 1899" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Marshall that the ordinance as read be passed for publication. Motion carried.

A proposed ordinance entitled "An ordinance concerning salaries of certain City employees" was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Hampson that the ordinance as read be passed for publication. Motion carried.

The following resolution was introduced and read.

RESOLUTION

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colo:

That each bank in the City of Grand Junction receiving City funds from the City Treasurer shall be required to at once give a depository bond running to the City Treasurer of the City of Grand Junction in the penal sum equal to the maximum amount of City funds deposited in said bank during the preceding year, plus ten percent.

It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Dowrey, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted. The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Councilmen voted as follows; Hirons, yea; Marshall, yea; Miller, yea; Dowrey, yea; Meders,

yea; Hampson, yea; Murr, yea. All the Councilmen voting yea, the motion was declared carried.

A contract pertaining to the collection of garbage was read by the Clerk.

Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Hampson, that a call for bids be issued subject to the terms of said contract. Motion carried.

A communication from Frank Brewer in reference to holding a Rodeo Show at Lincoln Park in June was read. This matter was referred to City Manager Garrett for investigation and recommendation.

The report of the City Weigher for the month of January was presented and read. Moved by Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Dowrey that the report be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

The question of raising the water rates was discussed at some length by the Council. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Dowrey, that the City Manager and the City Attorney draft an ordinance revising the water rates now in effect and that the City Manager make a report on said proposed ordinance after obtaining data from other cities. The motion carried.

The matter of erecting street signs in the City was brought up for discussion. Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders, that the City Manager carry on the necessary investigation and present his.

Moved by Councilman Hampson, seconded by Councilman Meders that the meeting adjourn, Motion carried.
