

MINUTES  
March 15, 1922

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session at 7:30 P.M. with President Hirons presiding. The Councilmen present were Hirons, Miller, Dowrey, Meders, Hampson and Murr. Councilman Marshall was absent on account of sickness. City Manager Garrett, City Auditor Peck, City Treasurer Bunting and City Attorney Jordan were present.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved. Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders, that Chas. H. Crawford be appointed to the position of City Treasurer. The motion being put, upon call of roll the Councilmen present voted as follows: Hirons, yea; Miller nay; Dowrey, nay; Meders, yea, Hampson, yea; Murr, yea. The majority of the Council present voting yea, the motion was declared carried and Chas. H. Crawford declared duly appointed.

Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Hampson, that the City Treasurer be paid the sum of \$125.00 each month. The motion being put, upon call of roll the Councilmen present voted as follows: Hirons, yea; Miller, yea; Dowrey, yea; Meders, yea; Hampson, yea; Murr, yea. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the motion was declared carried.

A communication from the Holly Sugar Corporation in regard to the proposed raise of water rents was read. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Miller that the communication be referred to the City Manager who will inform the company as to the probable rates. Motion carried.

Committees from the Chamber of Commerce, the Lion's Club and from the Grand Junction Band appeared before the Council asking that the City help in the support of the band for the year. It was moved by Councilman Dowrey, seconded by Councilman Meders, that the City Manager ascertain the conditions of the City funds to find what possibilities the City would have in donating a certain fund for the support of the band. Motion carried.

E.J. Cooper, licensed electrician, requested that his license be transferred to the firm of Forth and Cooper. Moved by Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Miller, that the matter be referred to Fire Chief Hynes for his recommendation. Motion carried. Moved by Councilman Miller, seconded by Councilmen Meders, that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
