MINUTES April 29, 1922

All the Councilmen having been duly notified, a special meeting on call of the President was convened at 7:00 P.M. The Council men present were, Hirons, Meders, Dowrey, Hampson and Murr. City Manager Garrett, and City Clerk Peck were present. Councilmen Marshall and Miller were absent. City Attorney Jordan was absent.

The President of the Council stated that the meeting was called to consider the purchase of certain road equipment.

After some consideration of the kind of equipment to buy it was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders, that that the City Manager be authorized and instructed to proceed with the purchase of one Buffalo-Pitts Combination Roller and Scarifier; cost, \$5,175.00. That he be authorized to sell the Iroquois Tandem Roller for the sum of \$900.00. That he be also authorized to sell the three old Troy dump wagons to the highest bidder and to buy three new Troy dump wagons.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Councilmen present voted as follows: Hirons, yea; Meders, yea; Dowrey, yea; Hampson, yea; Murr, yea. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the motion was declared carried.

There being no further business to bring before the Council the meeting was adjourned.
