

MINUTES
May 12, 1922

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in adjourned session at 7:30 P.M. with President Hirons presiding. The Councilmen present were Hirons, Marshall, Meders and Murr. City Manager Garrett, City Attorney Jorday and City Clerk Peck were present.

Proposals from the engineering firms of Burns and McDonnell, Stephens and Koon and from the Weiland Engineering Company relative to the contemplated water survey were the subject of discussion. No definite decision was reached as the terms of the proposals were vague in a few respects. City Manager Garrett was asked to write the firms submitting proposals asking them to explain certain parts of the proposal submitted.

There being no further business to come before the meeting the Council adjourned.
