

Grand Junction, Colorado
June 7, 1922

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colo. met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. with Councilman Hirons presiding. The Councilmen present were, Hirons, Marshall, Meders, Hampson and Murr. Councilman Miller and Dowrey were absent.

City Manager Garrett, City Attorney Jordan and City Clerk Peck were present.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved.

A delegation representing the property owners on south Seventh Street were present on request of the Council to talk over the paving of that street. No definite steps were taken in the matter as the owners were undecided as to the width and kind of paving wanted.

A petition requesting the paving of Rood Ave. from 2nd, St. to 7th. St. was presented.

It was moved by Councilman Marshall, seconded by Councilman Meders that the petition be accepted and placed on file. Motion carried.

The proposed ordinance entitled "An ordinance accepting the Moyer Natatorium in Lincoln Park and providing regulations for the use thereof" was presented and read.

It was moved by Councilman Hampson, seconded by Councilman Meders that the proposed ordinance entitled "An ordinance entitled" An ordinance accepting the Moyer Natatorium in Lincoln Park and providing regulations for the use thereof" be passed for publication.

Upon call of roll the Councilmen voted as follows, Hirons, yea; Marshall, yea; Meders, yea; Hampson, yea; Murr, yea. All the Councilmen present voting yea; the motion was declared carried.

City Attorney Jordon reported that the Council had no power to cause the removal of the lunch rooms situated on the Corner of Main and Third Sts unless it could be proven that the lunch cars

had moved to their present locations after the establishment of the Fire Limits.

It was moved by Councilman Hampson, seconded by Councilman Marshall that the City Attorney prepare the necessary instruments to cause the removal of the Pioneer Ditch located in the North East portion of the City. Motion carried.

Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Hampson that the Council meet once a month instead of twice each month and that the regular meetings be held on the first Wednesday of each month. Motion carried.

Their being no further business to come before the meeting the Council adjourned until Wednesday June 14 at 7:30 P.M.
