

Grand Junction, Colorado
July 13, 1922

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met at 8:00 o'clock P.M. with President Hampson Pro Tem presiding. The Councilmen present were Hampson, Miller, Meders, Dowrey Marshall and Murr. City Manager Garrett, and City Treasurer Crawford were present. City Attorney Jordan and City Clerk Peck were absent.

It was moved by Councilman Marshall, seconded by Councilman Dowrey that C.H. Crawford act as City Clerk Pro Tem during the absence of Mr. Peck. Motion carried.

A petition for the paving of Grand Ave. from Seventh Street to Twelfth Street was presented and read. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders that the petition be accepted and filed and that the same be referred to the City Manager and City Engineer to verify the frontage signed for. Motion carried.

Representatives of the Banking House of Avery, Boardman and Traylor appeared before the Council entertaining a proposition for the refunding of \$439,000 worth of water bonds due July 1 1926. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Marshal that the President appoint a committee to investigate to advisability of refunding the issue. Motion carried. The President then appointed the following persons to act

Councilman Murr

City Manager Garrett

City Attorney Jordan

City Treasurer Crawford.

It was moved by Councilman Marshall seconded by Councilman Dowrey taht the City Manager investigate the matter of providing a sanitary toilet at the City Cemetary. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come befor the meeting the Council was adjourned by the President until July 19 1922 at 8:00 P.m.
