

Grand Junction, Colorado
August 2, 1922

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session at 8:00 P.M. with Councilman Hampson President Pro Tem presiding. The Councilmen present were; Hampson, Marshall, Miller and Murr. Councilmen Dowrey, Meders, and Hirons were absent.

City Manager Garrett, City Attorney Jordan and City Auditor Peck were present.

The minutes of the last regular session and of the adjourned meetings of July 13 and 19th were read and approved.

A petition for sewer on North Seventh Street was presented and read. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Miller that the petition be accepted and filed and that the City Engineer be authorized to make the necessary surveys for a preliminary estimate. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Miller that the action taken by the City Council toward accepting and filing the petition for Paving No. Seventh on July 5th and toward the petition for paving Grand Ave on July 13 be recinded as the petitions were not acknowledged. Motion carried.

It was then moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Marshall that the Grand Ave and No. Seventh Paving petitions be referred to the City Manager, City Attorney and City Clerk. Motion carried.

The report of the City Manager for the second quarter of 1922 was presented and read.

It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Miller that the report be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

The preliminary report of the Engineering firm of Burns and Mc Donnel on the improvement of the water system was presented and read. Action on the report was deferred until the next meeting.

It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Miller that the City Attorney and the City Manager investigate the purchase of a site for a new reservoir. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the meeting the Council adjourned until 8:00 P.M. August 9 1922.
