

Grand Junction, Colorado
September 25, 1922

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular adjourned session at the call of the chair at 7:30 P.M. with President Hirons presiding. The Councilmen present were Hirons, Marshall, Murr, Dowery and Miller. Councilmen Hampson and Meders were absent. City Manager Garrett, City Attorney Jordan, and City Clerk Peck were present.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the City water rates for manufacturing concerns with the Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Weiser addressed the Council stating that in the mind of the Chamber of Commerce the water rates for the factories and manufacturing concerns were excessive and asked the Council that it take steps to find out whether they could be lowered and still conform with the City Charter. This matter was referred to City Manager Garrett and City Attorney Jordan they to report their findings at the next regular meeting.

Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Miller that C.H. Crawford, City Treasurer be appointed to serve as Treasurer of the Fireman's Pension Board to fill the vacancy made by Mark R. Bunting. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Marshall, seconded by Councilman Miller that the Council adjourn to the call of the Chair. Motion carried.
