Grand Junction, Colorado October 4, 1922

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session at 8:00 o'clock P.M. with President Hirons presiding. The Councilmen present were: Hirons, Meders, Hampson and Murr. Councilman Marshall, Miller and Dowrey were absent. City Manager Garrett, City Attorney Jordan City Clerk Peck and City Engineer Thompson were present.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved and also the minutes of the regular adjourned meetings of Sept. 15, 16, 21, 22, and 22nd, 1922 were read and approved.

W.S. Wallace appeared before the Council asking for information concerning the erection of an apple drying plant on the Corner of South Ave. and Eight Street. An application for the permission of the Council to erect such a plant was filed by S.J. Gaumer.

It was moved by Councilman Hampson, seconded by Councilman Meders that the appointment of Sam B. Berry as Municipal Judge be recinded as he had failed to qualify. Motion carried.

It was then moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders that Henry Grubbs be appointed to fill the position of Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Grand Junction at a salary of \$25.00 per month, said position to be retained during the pleasure of the City Council. The motion being put, upon call of roll the Councilmen present voted as follows, Hirons, yea; Meders, yea; Hampson, yea; Murr, yea. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the motion was declared carried.

The bond of Strange and Maguire Paving Company for \$36,600.00 for the construction of Paving District No. 6 was read. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders that the bond be accepted and filed on the approval of the City Attorney. The City Attorney then approved the bond. The motion being put, upon call of roll the Councilmen present voted as follows; Hirons, yea; Meders, yea; Hampson, yea; Murr, yea. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the motion was declared carried.

It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders that the contract for the construction of Paving District No. 6 by Strange and Maguire Paving Company be approved. The motion being put, upon call or roll the Councilmen voted as follows, Hirons, yea; Meders, yea; Hampson, yea; Murr, yea. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the motion was declared carried. The bond of Leslie White for an electricians license having been approved by the City Attorney was presented. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Upon the motion of Councilman Hampson, seconded by Councilman Meders the meeting adjourned upon call of the President.
