Thereupon Councilman Miller, seconded by Councilman Meders that Mrs. Tillie Mort be named to serve as judge in Precinct # 9 to take the place of Ben Snyder who was unable to serve, Mrs. Della Taylor to fill the vacancy left by Mrs. Madge Sweitzer who was not a qualified voter, Mrs. Henry Rhone to fill the vacancy left by Henry Rhone who was unable to serve, Mrs. Mary A Beebe to take the place of Mrs. J.A. Brisinhan who was unable to serve and that E.W. Van Gundy be appointed to serve in the place of his wife Mrs. E.W. Van Gundy, upon which motion the following vote was cast:

Councilmen voting Yea: Murr, Meders, Marshall, and Dowrey.

Councilmen voting Nay: None.

The President Pro Tem declared the motion carried and the City Clerk was instructed to notify the persons selected.

There being no further business to come before the meeting it was moved by Councilman Dowrey, seconded by Councilman Miller that the meting adjourn. Motion carried.
