

Grand Junction, Colorado

All the members of the Council being duly notified the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular adjourned session at 11:00 o'clock A.M. with President Hirons presiding. The Councilmen present were Councilmen: Hirons, Marshall, Dowrey and Hampson Councilmen Miller, Murr, and Meders were absent.

The President stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the purchase of trucks owned by the State of Colorado.

It was moved by Councilman Dowrey, seconded by Councilman Marshall that the City Manager go to Denver to look over the trucks and other equipment with the view to the purchase of the same. He to be given the power to purchase the equipment needed by the City if to his judgement the equipment was worth the purchase price, upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting Yea; Hirons, Marshall, Dowrey, and Hampson. Councilmen voting Nay: None. All the Councilmen voting yea, the motion was declared carried.
