Grand Junction, Colorado

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular adjourned session at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. on the above date at the regular meeting place. President Hirons presided. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen: Hirons, Marshall, Meders, Miller, Hampson, and Murr. City, Manager Carrett, City Attorney Jordan, City Clerk Peck and City Engineer Thompson. Councilman Dowrey was absent.

Frank Whittaker representative of the Lions Club was present requesting permission to remark the trail markings on the highways entering the city. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Miller that the request be granted. Motion carried.

The matter of rerouting the highways was discussed. Upon motion of Councilman Hampson and seconded by Councilman Moders this matter was referred to the President of the council for consideration.

The surety bond of the Strange-MaGuire Paving Company was presented for acceptance, the same having been approved by the City Attorney. It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Medors that the bond of the Strange MaGuire Paving Company for the construction of Paving District No. 10 be accepted and approved and that the President of the Council be authorized to sign the contract with said company on behalf of the City. Upin this motion the following vote was cast; Councilmen voting Yea, Hirons, Marshall, Miller, Meders, Hampson and Murr. All the Councilmen present voting Yea, the President declared the motion carried.
