

Grand Junction, Colo.

November 12 1924

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular adjourned session at 8:00 o'clock P.M. with President Hirons presiding. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Hirons, Meders, Miller, Murr & Bear; City Manager Garrett, City Clerk Peck were present. Councilmen Dowrey and Hampson were absent. City Attorney Jordan was absent.

The Clerk announced that no claims had been filed against W.O. Allison, Contractor, for the construction of Sidewalk District No. 8.

Councilman Miller moved, seconded by Councilman Murr that the City Clerk and City Manager be authorized to draw a warrant in favor of W.O. Allison in the amount of \$3735.23, being the amount of the final estimate on Sidewalk District No. 8. Upon this motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting yea, Hirons, Miller, Meders, Murr and Bear. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the President declared the motion carried.

Moved by councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders that all the applications as read be passed with the exception of the application of Santiago Arangeuren at 326 So. Second St. Motion carried.

Councilman Murr moved, seconded by Councilman Meders that the City Attorney draft an ordinance to prohibit the sale and use of Mariguina (Indian Hemp). Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Council the meeting was adjourned upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Bear.
