November 20, 1924.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado met in regular session at 8:00 o'clock P.M. with President Hirons presiding. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Hirons, Meders, Bear, Murr and Hampson; City Manager Garrett, City Attorney Jordan and City Clerk Peck. Councilmen Dowrey & Miller were absent.

The minutes of the meetings of November 6th & November 12th were read and approved.

A proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING CANNABIS SATIVA (ALSO KNOWN AS CANNABIS INDICA, INDIAN HEMP AND MARIGUANA) was introduced and read.

Councilman Murr moved, seconded by Councilman Bear that the Ordinance as read be passed for publication. Motion carried.

A discussion regarding defective sidewalks in the city was entered into.

It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders that the City Clerk give legal notice to the following persons owning the following property that the sidewalk adjacent to their property must be repaired within thirty days in accordance with Ordinance No. 178, and in conformity with the specifications as set forth by Ordinance No. 182. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting yea, Hirons, Meders, Bear, Murr & Hampson. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the President declared the motion carried.
