

Grand Junction, Colorado

November 28 1924

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular adjourned session at 8:00 o'clock P.M. with President Hirons presiding; Those present and answering at roll call were Hirons, Hampson Bear, Murr, Meders & Dowrey. Councilman Miller was absent. City Manager Garrett, City Attorney Jordan and City Clerk Peck were present. Councilman Meders & Dowrey were excused by the President after the meeting was called to order.

It was moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Hampson that the City Council fix the tax levy for the year 1925 at 14 mills on each dollar of assessable property within the corporate limits of the City of Grand Junction, and that the City Clerk notify the County Assessor of said action. Upon this motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen present voting yea, Hirons, Hampson, Bear & Murr. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the President declared the motion carried.

The proof of publication of the proposed ordinance entitled "A SPECIAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE PARK DEPARTMENT" was read. Upon motion of Councilman Hampson, seconded by Councilman Murr the proof was accepted and ordered filed.

Upon motion of Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Bear the proposed ordinance was ordered up for final passage.

Councilman Hampson moved, seconded by a Councilman Murr that the proposed ordinance entitled "A SPECIAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE PARK DEPARTMENT" be passed and adopted as read and numbered 367. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen present voting yea, Hirons, Hampson, Bear & Murr. All the Councilmen present voting year, the President declared the motion carried.

A proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 362 PASSED AND ADOPTED THE 19TH DAY OF MAY, 1924, AND ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 316, PASSED AND ADOPTED THE FIRST DAY OF MAY, 1922, AND ENTITLED' AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 301, PASSED AND ADOPTED THE 26TH DAY OF JULY, 1921, AND ENTITLED' A BUILDING ORDINANCE AND ALSO CONCERNING THE STORAGE AND HANDLING OF GASOLENE AND AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 301, PASSED AND ADOPTED THE 26TH DAY OF MAY, 1921, AND ENTITLED A BUILDING ORDINANCE AND ALSO CONCERNING THE STORAGE AND HANDLING OF GASOLENE" was introduced and read. Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Bear that the proposed ordinance be passed for publication. Motion carried.

A proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 301, PASSED AND ADOPTED THE 26TH DAY OF JULY, 1921, AND ENTITLED "A BUILDING ORDINANCE AND ALSO CONCERNING THE STORAGE AND HANDLING OF GASOLINE" was introduced and read. Moved by Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Bear that the proposed ordinance be passed for publication. Motion carried.

A Junk License for the balance of the year 1924 was transferred from Geo. Butcher to D.L. Cook, upon motion of Councilman Bear, seconded by Councilman Murr.

There being no further business to come before the Council the meeting adjourned.
