

Grand Junction, Colorado

December 8 1924

All the Councilmen being duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. with President Hirons presiding. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Bear, Dowrey, Miller, Hampson and Hirons, City Manager Garrett, City Clerk Peck and City Attorney Jordan. Councilmen Meders & Murr were absent.

The President stated that the purpose of the meeting was the consideration of the bill of S. N. Wheeler for legal services rendered in the case of Etta Gardner vs. The City of Grand Junction.

A letter was read from S.N. Wheeler in regard to said claim.

After some discussion it was moved by Councilman Dowrey, seconded by Councilman Miller that the President of the Council appoint a committee to interview Judge N.C. Miller to ascertain if he would act as arbiter in the matter of the \$2,000.00 bill for legal services submitted by S.N. Wheeler, in the case of Etta Gardner vs. the City of Grand Junction, and that the City Clerk notify S.N. Wheeler of the action taken. Said Committee to ascertain the amount of the expense connected with the rendering of the opinion and that if the committee deems it advisable they have the authority of appointing Judge N.C. Miller as arbiter, if he so accepts. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting yea, Bear, Dowrey, Miller, Hampson & Hirons. All the Councilmen present voting yea, the President declared the motion carried. The President of the Council appointed the following committee to act with him. Councilman Bear and Dowrey.

There being no further business to come before the Council they adjourned upon motion of Councilman Bear seconded by Councilman Miller.
