All the Councilmen first being duly notified the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in special session at 9:00 o'clock A.M. President Hirons presided.

Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Bear, Dowrey, Hampson, Meders, Miller, Murr & Hirons. City Manager Garrett & City Clerk Peck were also present. City Attorney Jordan was absent.

The meeting was called to dispose of the \$2,000 bill for legal services performed by Attorney S.N. Wheeler.

The President of the Council called a recess until 11:00 o'clock A.M.

The council convened again at 11:00 o'clock A.M. with all the Councilmen present.

A letter from S.N. Wheeler was read. The letter stated that he would reduce his bill to \$1750.00 provided that it was settled at once.

Councilman Murr moved, seconded by Councilman Dowrey that the Council allow the bill of \$1750.00 to S.N. Wheeler for legal services in the case of Etta Gardner vs The City of Grand Junction, and that the City Manager and the City Auditor be authorized to draw said warrant. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting yea, Bear, Dowrey, Meders, Miller, Hampson, Murr & Hirons. All the Councilmen voting yea, the president declared the motion carried.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned upon motion of Councilman Hampson, seconded by Councilman Bear.
