

Grand Junction, Colorado
April 1, 1925

The city Council of the City of Grand Junction met irregular session at 8:00 o'clock P.M. with President Hirons presiding. Those present and answering at roll, call were Councilmen: Hirons, Meders, Miller, Bear & Murr. Councilmen Dowrey & Hampson were absent. City Manager Garrett, City Clerk Peck were present. City Attorney Tupper was absent.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved.

The Park Garage made application for a permit to install a curb gasoline pump near the curb at their place of business on South 5th St. Upon motion of Councilman Murr, seconded by Councilman Meders the permit was granted.
