

Grand Junction, Colo.

August 26 1925.

All the Councilmen being duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. with President Bell Presiding. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen: Ellison, Bear, Logsdan, Meders, Moslander & Bell. City Manager Thompson, City Clerk Peck & City Attorney Hinman were present. Councilman Short was absent.

Mr. Bradbury of Kannah Creek was present in regard to the finishing of a cabin on the proposed city reservoir site on Grand Mesa. The Council referred this matter to the City Manager.

The proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9 OF ORDINANCE NO. 333 ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 313 ENTITLED AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE WATER RATES OR RENTS AND THE COLLECTION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICTION WITH THIS ORDINANCE, PASSED AND ADOPTED THE 22nd DAY OF MARCH, 1922, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 9" was introduced and read. Upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Bear & unanimously carried the proposed ordinance was passed for publication.

The proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ASHES; THE STORAGE AND DEPOSIT THEREOF IN RECEPTACLES AND PITS, THE REQUIREMENTS OF CONSTRUCTION OF ASH PITS AND RECEPTACLES FOR ASHES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF" was introduced and read. Upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Bear and unanimously carried the proposed ordinance was passed for publication.

A proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STREET TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO" was introduced & read. Upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Bear the same was ordered tabled.

The matter of granting the Grand Junction Ice Cream Company a permit to erect a corrugated iron shed adjacent to their building on Main St was discussed. Councilman Meders moved, seconded by Councilman Bear that the permit be not granted and that the building inspector be instructed to order the removal of a corrugated iron shed owned and built by the C.D. Smith drug Company & located on lots 31 & 32 Blk. 120. Said shed being build without authority from the Council & also in violation of the building ordinance of the City. The motion being put all the Councilmen present voted Yea and the President declared the motion carried.

J.W. Norviel Community Service Director made a report of the activities of his department.

Councilman Meders moved, seconded by Councilman Logsdon that the President appoint a committee of three to meet with the school board to discuss the matter of the continuance of the Com. service dept. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the meeting the Council adjourned upon motion of Councilman Ellison, seconded by Councilman Moslander.
