

Grand Junction, Colorado

December 2 1925

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. with President Bell Presiding. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilman Bear, Ellison, Fairley, Logsden, Meders, Moslander & Bell, City Manager Thompson, City Clerk Peck & City Attorney Hinman.

The minutes of the last regular and of the adjourned session on November 30 were read and approved.

A bond was filed by H.E. Lurie with his application for auctioneer's license, the same having been approved by the City Attorney.

Upon motion of Councilman Logsden, seconded by Councilman Meders the bond was accepted and a license ordered granted to H.E. Lurie with the provision that his sale close December 5th 1925. Motion carried.

Councilman Fairley moved seconded by Councilman Logsden that the Chief of the Fire Department be allowed \$10.00 per month for gasoline and oil for his car. Motion carried.

Revision of the license ordinance was discussed at length.

Councilman Meders moved, seconded by Councilman Bear that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
