

Grand Junction, Colorado.

November 17th, 1926

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. with President Bell presiding. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Bell, Bear, Meders, Fairley, Moslander, Ellison, and Logsdon. City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Niles were present.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved.

The contracts for construction of Paving District No. 17 were presented for the signature of the President of the City Council.

It was moved by Councilman Logsdon, seconded by Councilman Fairley that the bond of the Strange-Maguire Paving Company be approved and that the President of the City Council be authorized to sign the contract. Motion carried.

An application from L. J. Funk for a permit to park his automobile in front of the Richardson Drug Store at 449 Main Street, as a permanent stage stand or depot for the convenience of passengers traveling between Palisade and Grand Junction, was presented and read. It was moved by Councilman Bear seconded by Councilman Meders that this application be turned over to the City Manager, with power to act on it. Motion carried.

The matter of the hotel permit for Mrs. Alice Baine, 550-560 South Avenue was presented. It was moved by Councilman Bear, seconded by Councilman Moslander that the permit be denied. Motion carried.

The proof of publication of the proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ON CERTAIN REAL ESTATE IN GRAND JUNCTION FOR BENEFITS CONFERRED BY THE WATER WORKS OF THE SAID CITY" was read by the Clerk. Upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Bear, the proof of publication was accepted and ordered filed.

The proposed ordinance was then read by the Clerk, and upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Bear, the same was ordered up for final passage.

Councilman Meders thereupon moved, seconded by Councilman Bear, that the proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ON CERTAIN REAL ESTATE IN GRAND JUNCTION FOR BENEFITS CONFERRED BY THE WATER WORKS OF THE SAID CITY", be passed and adopted, numbered 407, and published, upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting "Yea", Bear, Meders, Moslander, Ellison, Logsdon, Fairley, Bell. All the

Councilmen voting "Yea", the President declared the motion carried and the Ordinance duly passed and adopted.

The "Proof of Publication" of the proposed Ordinance entitled "THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1st, A. D. 1927, and ENDING DECEMBER 31st, A. D. 1927" was read by the Clerk. Upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Fairley, the proof of publication was accepted and ordered filed.

The proposed ordinance was then read by the Clerk and upon motion of Councilman Bear, seconded by Councilman Fairley, was brought up for final passage.

Councilman Bear moved, seconded by councilman Fairley that the proposed Ordinance entitled "THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1st, A. D. 1927, and JANUARY 1st, A. D. 1927 and ENDING DECEMBER 31st, 1927" be passed and adopted, numbered 408, and published. Upon which motion the following vote was cast. Councilmen voting "Yea" - Bear, Meders, Moslander, Ellison, Logsdon, Fairley, Bell. All Councilmen voting "Yea", the President declared the motion carried and the ordinance duly passed and adopted.

There being no further business to come before the Council on motion of Councilman Ellison, seconded by Councilman Meders, the meeting adjourned.
