A special meeting of the Council was called to consider the report of Mr. John C. Page, Engineer, who had been engaged to make a study of the reservoirs on Grand Mesa. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Moslander, Penberthy, Meders, Rogers, Hall, Ellison. Councilman Bear was absent. City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Niles were present.

The matter of the bond and license of John Logan as electrician was brought up before the Council. The Fire Chief and Assistant Fire Chief and City Electrician appeared before the Council and informed them that in their judgment the applicant was not competent to properly install electrical wiring and apparatus in accordance with the rules and regulations of the City ordinances, and recommended that the license be not granted.

Mr. Page presented a written report on the reservoirs on the Kannah Creek watershed, and discussed the matter with the Council.

Councilman Hall moved, Councilman Penberthy seconded the motion that the report of John C. Page be accepted and ordered filed. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion of Councilman Hall, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
