December 21st, 1927.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall, Ellison, Moslander. City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman, City Clerk Niles.

The minutes of the regular meeting of December 7th were read and approved.

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Penberthy seconded the motion that Messrs. C. J. Bradfield and Clyde H. Biggs be appointed to take the places of Messrs A. T. Gormley and Henry Tupper on the Zoning Board. Motion carried.

The Proof of Publication of the Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES" was presented. Councilman Meders moved, Councilman Bear seconded the motion that the Proof of Publication be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

The proposed ordinance was then read by the Clerk, and upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Rogers, the proposed ordinance was called up for final passage. Motion carried.

Councilman Ellison thereupon moved, seconded by Councilman Penberthy, that the proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES" be passed and adopted, numbered 426, and published. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall, Ellison, Moslander. Councilmen voting NO, None. All the Councilmen present voted YEA, the President declared the motion carried, and the ordinance duly passed and adopted.

The matter of giving the M. System Meat Market a rebate on their license for the year 1927 on account of their having opened the market so late in the year was brought up and discussed.

Councilman Bear moved, Councilman Rogers seconded the motion that the request of the M. System Butcher shop for rebate on their license be denied, and the officers instructed to collect the license fee. Motion carried.

Representatives from the Bakers in the City of Grand Junction presented a petition to the Council asking that the ordinance accompanying the petition standardizing the weight of loaves of bread be passed.

After the matter was discussed, Councilman Penberthy moved, Councilman Meders seconded the motion that the ordinance be passed for publication: Motion carried.

City Manager Thompson gave a verbal report on his trip to Greeley, Fort. Collins, Pueblo, & Denver.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion of Councilman Penberthy, seconded by Councilman Meders, the meeting adjourned.
