The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Moslander, Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall, Ellison. City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman, City Clerk Niles were present.

The minutes of the regular meeting held March 7th were read and approved.

Zoning:

It had been duly advertised, in compliance with the statutes, that the matter of the proposed zoning ordinance would be brought up. Mrs. Janet B. Engert, members of the Christian Science Church board, Mr. Bowman, and others were present, requesting that various lots on White Avenue be included in Business "B" District instead of Residence "E" District. After discussing this and other zoning matters at length, it was decided to try and hold a meeting with the members of the zoning commission, to get their opinion on the proposed changes.

Several other matters were brought up and discussed, but no action was taken.

It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Rogers that the meeting adjourn to meet with members of the zoning commission at a date mutually convenient with the Council and zoning commission.
