

Grand Junction, Colorado

June 20, 1928

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Moslander, Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall. Councilman Ellison was absent. City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Pro-tem Sackett were present.

The minutes of the previous regular and intervening special meetings were read and approved.

City Clerk Pro-tem, W. L. Sackett reported no protests had been filed on Paving District No. 20 and Sidewalk District No. 10.

The City Clerk Pro-Tem proceeded to open the sealed bids for bonds of Paving District No. 20 and Sidewalk District No. 10. The following bids were tabulated:

Councilman Meders moved and Councilman Bear seconded the motion that the resolution creating Paving District No. 20 and Sidewalk District No. 10 and all bids for bonds be laid on the table until further action of the Council. Motion carried.

Councilman Rogers moved and Councilman Meders seconded the motion that the first regular July meeting be held July 2nd on account of the first regular meeting falling on July 4th. Motion carried.

Councilman Penberthy moved and Councilman Meders seconded the motion that the action of the City Manager in sending the City Clerk as a delegate to the annual meeting of the Colorado Municipal League held in Sterling, Colorado, June 14th, 15th, & 16th be ratified. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Councilman Meders and duly carried that the meeting adjourn.
