Grand Junction, Colorado

August 15, 1928

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall, Ellison, Moslander. City Manager Thompson, City Clerk Niles were present. City Attorney Hinman was absent.

The minutes of the regular meeting held August 1st were read and approved.

Prop. Ord. Conc. coal & coke

A proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LICENSE AND REGULATION OF THE SALE OR DELIVERY OF COAL AND COKE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, was presented and read. It was moved by Councilman Penberthy and seconded by Councilman Meders that the proposed ordinance be laid on the table. Motion carried.

The Proof of Publication of the Ordinance entitled "AND ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS IN SLOCOMB'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION WAS presented. It was moved by Councilman Meders and seconded by Councilman Penberthy that the Proof of Publication be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

The proposed ordinance was then read, and upon motion of Councilman Meders, seconded by Councilman Penberthy and duly carried was called up for final passage.

Ord. No. 436

Councilman Bear thereupon moved, seconded by Councilman Ellison that the ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS IN SLOCOMB'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION be passed and adopted, numbered 436, and published. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall, Ellison, Moslander. All the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

Several other items were brought up and discussed but no definite action taken on anything.

On motion of Councilman Bear, seconded by Councilman Meders, the meeting adjourned.
