

Grand Junction, Colorado

September 19, 1928

City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman and City Clerk Niles Were present.

It was moved by Councilman Penberthy and seconded by Councilman Rogers that Councilman Meders act as President Pro-tem. Motion carried. Councilman Meders then took the Chair.
