Municipal baseball equipment

It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Councilman Meders that the sum of \$300.00 be included in the budget for buying athletic equipment. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall, Ellison, Moslander. All the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

Free rest room rent eliminated

It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Councilman Meders that the sum of \$150.00 for rent of Free rest room for the year 1929 be eliminated from the budget. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall, Ellison, Moslander. All the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

1929 levy fixed

It was moved by Councilman Meders and seconded by Councilman Bear that the levy for 1929 be fixed at thirteen and one-half mills (\$.00135) for General Funds and that the City Clerk be instructed to certify this amount to the County Assessor. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Penberthy, Meders, Bear, Rogers, Hall, Ellison, Moslander. Councilmen voting NAY, None. Motion carried.

Klein Land Co.

It was moved by Councilman Meders and seconded by Councilman Bear that the City Manager be instructed to write a letter to the editors of both papers defining the attitude of the City Council in the matter of the published statements of the Board of County Commissioners in the Klein Land matter. Motion carried.

Councilman Penberthy moved and Councilman Meders seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
