July 3rd, 1929

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. Councilman Penberthy was absent. City Manager, Thompson, City Attorney, Hinman, and City Clerk, Niles were present.

The minutes of the previous session held June 19th were read and approved.

N. Mex. Const. Co. bond Pav. Dist. 21 accepted

The bond of the New Mexico Construction Company for Paving District No. 21 was presented. Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Hirons seconded the motion that the President of the Council and the City Clerk be authorized to sign the acceptance of the bond and that the bond be accepted and filed. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA - Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All the Councilmen present voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

City Atty draw up ord. On radio interference

A copy of an ordinance concerning radio interference was presented by the Chamber of Commerce. Councilman Sievert moved and Councilman Glassford seconded the motion that the City Attorney be instructed to draw up an ordinance concerning radio interference. Motion carried.

Johnson bill for damages

Mr. Johnson came before the Council and presented a bill for damage claimed to be caused by the City dumping dirt on their irrigation ditch north west of the City limits. Councilman Glassford moved and Councilman Hirons seconded the motion that the bill be referred to the City Manager for investigation, and to report back to the Council at the next meeting.

Ord. Re Salary of Mun. judge

A Proposed Ordinance Concerning the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court was introduced and read. It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Glassford that the proposed ordinance be passed for publication. Motion carried.

Colo. Mun. League Conv. in Grand Junction

A letter from Mr. Don C. Sowers, Secretary of the Colorado Municipal League, pertaining to the convention which will be held in Grand Junction September 9, 10, & 11, was read. Councilman Hall moved that the matter of making arrangements for the convention of the Colorado Municipal League be referred to the City Manager and the committee on Public Affairs, with power to make such arrangements as they think advisable. Councilman Hirons seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made, seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
