

Grand Junction, Colorado

October 16th, 1929

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk, Tomlinson were present.

The minutes of the regular meeting held October 2nd were read and approved.

Rettig Pkg. Co. City Ins. Mileage

The matter of charging the Rettig Packing Co. for transportation for the City Inspector in making trips to their plant for the purpose of examining meat products was brought up and discussed. City Manager Thompson was instructed to get in touch with Mr. Rettig and discuss this matter before any action is taken by the Council.

Several matters pertaining to the Municipal Airport were discussed.

Airport

Councilman Glassford moved and Councilman Hirons seconded the motion that the City grant a lease to Mr. Young for the use of the landing field for student flying for one year - optional two years - at 5% of the tuition received by him with a minimum after January 1st, 1930 of \$50.00 per month, subject to the approval of the City Attorney and the airport committee as to details, and subject to the approval of the next Council, in office after the first Monday in May, 1931. Motion carried.

Several matters pertaining to the 1930 budget were brought up and discussed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion of Councilman Penberthy, seconded by Councilman Bear, the meeting adjourned until Wednesday evening, October 30th, 1929, at 7:30 o'clock P.M.
