City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

1930 budget

The City Manager presented the proposed budget for 1930, which was discussed at length.

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Penberthy seconded the motion that the budget be accepted as read. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA - Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All the Councilmen present voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

levy fixed

It was moved by Councilman Penberthy and seconded by Councilman Glassford that the levy for 1930 be fixed at thirteen and one-half mills (\$.00135) for General Funds and that the City Clerk be instructed to certify this amount to the County Assessor. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA - Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

Western Union license

It was moved by Councilman Hirons and seconded by Councilman Bear that the President of the Council, the City Manager, and the City Attorney meet with Western Union officials to see what arrangements can be made for the Western Union to pay a license fee to the City of Grand Junction.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion of Councilman Glassford seconded by Councilman Penberthy, and duly carried, the meeting adjourned.
