All members having been notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in special session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. City Manager Thompson, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Fulton Pet. Corp. natural gas franchise submitted officials explains ordinance

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss a proposed franchise ordinance which had been submitted by the Fulton Petroleum Corporation, for the purpose of furnishing the City of Grand Junction with natural gas, and for any other business which might properly come before the Council.

Mr. C. A. Winder, Supervisor of Public Utilities of Fort Worth, Texas was present. Mr. Goodwin, Mr. Fulton, Mr. Smith, and other members of the Fulton Petroleum Corporation explained the ordinance as submitted, and explained to the Council what their company proposes to do. Several suggested changes to the ordinance were made by Mr. Winder. After considerable discussion, the Fulton Petroleum Corporation expressed the desire to submit the proposed changes to their office in Seattle, stating that they would report back at the regular meeting to be held December 18th, 1929.

Tax sale certificates

Mr. Thompson stated that Mr. Frank Federico offered \$100.00 for the tax certificates which have been issued on Lot 1, Block 10, Mobley's subdivision.

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Hirons seconded the motion that the City of Grand Junction sell to Mr. Frank Federico, the tax certificates on Lot 1, Block 10, Mobley's Subdivision. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA; Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. Councilman voting NO - None.
