

Grand Junction, Colorado

January 16, 1930

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 3:30 O'clock P. M. All members of the Council, City Attorney, City Manager, and City Clerk were present.

Councilman Bear moved and Councilman Sievert seconded the motion that the Council accept the tentative proposition of the Fulton Petroleum Company for a gas franchise subject to the submission of a revised form of ordinance, fully covering all matters which the Council may deem proper to include therein.

Councilmen voting No - None.

All the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Hirons and seconded by Councilman Glassford that the meeting adjourn to meet at the call of the President. Motion carried.
