The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. City Manager, Thompson, City Attorney Hinman, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Fulton Pet. Gas franchise

This meeting was called for the purpose of further considering the franchise with the Fulton Petroleum Corporation for furnishing the City of Grand Junction with natural gas.

Committee from C. of C.

A committee from the Chamber of Commerce had been selected to meet with the City Council and consider the franchise from all angles, and make any suggestions that they might deem advisable. The following men comprised the committee from the Chamber of Commerce, M. N. Due, C. S. Desch, C. D. Moslander, E. M. Goodrich, A. T. Gormley, B. M. Bengel, Harry Jones, B. H. Day, and John Page. The regular committee from the Chamber of Commerce were R. C. Miller, C. J. Bradfield, & John Evans.

After considerable discussion, several changes were suggested in the proposed franchise.

Councilman Hirons moved and Councilman Sievert seconded the motion that the franchise ordinance be corrected as suggested, and the same be forwarded to the Fulton Petroleum Corporation for their approval. Upon which motion the following vote was cast:

Councilmen voting YEA - Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers.

Councilmen voting NO - None.

All the Councilmen voting YEA - the President declared the motion carried.

Hinman resignation

Mr. W. R. Hinman, City Attorney presented his resignation, to take effect February 1st, 1930.

It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Penberthy that the resignation of Mr. Hinman, City Attorney, be

accepted, and that Mr. E. B. Adams, be appointed City Attorney, to take effect on February 1st, 1930. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Penberthy Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All the Councilmen present voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

Councilman Penberthy moved and Councilman Hirons seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
