

Grand Junction, Colorado

April 5, 1930

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Penberthy, Bear, Glassford, Hall, Hirons, Sievert, Rogers. City Attorney Adams, City Manager Thompson, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Captain Aubrey Kief, T. H. Sackett, Delbert Bullock, A. A. Sherred were present. Captain Kief is a representative of Curtiss-Wright Inc.

Re. airport lease

A tentative agreement between the City of Grand Junction and Mr. Sackett, whereby the City agreed to lease and demise to Mr. Sackett, the municipal airport field for the purpose of conducting a flying school, which includes a ground and flying course as outlined by Curtiss-Wright, Inc., and to develop other phases of aviation in connection with such school, was presented and discussed.

After considerable discussion, it was moved by Councilman Glassford and seconded by Councilman Hirons that the City Manager and City Attorney draft a lease to T. H. Sackett of Fort Collins, Colorado on the Municipal Airport, until May 1st, 1931 along the lines discussed between the Council and Mr. Sackett and set forth in the tentative draft of lease now before the Council, such lease to contain suitable forfeiture provisions for the protection of the City.

The question being upon the adoption of the motion, the roll was called with the following result:

Councilmen voting YEA - Bear, Glassford, Hall, Hirons, Sievert, Penberthy, Rogers.

Councilmen voting NO - None.

All of the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion of Councilman Penberthy, seconded by Councilman Hall, the meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the President. Motion carried.
