

Grand Junction, Colorado

July 16, 1930

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Bear, Hall, Hirons, Penberthy, Sievert, Glassford. President Rogers was absent. City Attorney Adams, Acting City Manager, Burroughs, and City Clerk, Tomlinson, were present. President Pro-tem, Glassford presided.

The minutes of the Regular meeting held July 2nd, and the regular adjourned meetings held July 3rd and July 8th were read and approved.

Re salaries

It was moved by Councilman Penberthy and seconded by Councilman Bear that the proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCES NO. 426, 443, 455, and 457, ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES'", be tabled indefinitely. Motion carried.

Burroughs bond

The \$10,000 surety bond of Acting City Manager, John J. Burroughs, having been approved as to form by the City Attorney, was presented. It was moved by Councilman Penberthy and seconded by Councilman Hall that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Proposed stadium

Considerable time was spent in discussing the proposed stadium to be built at Lincoln Park. Mr. Ford, structural engineer was present and discussed the matter with the Council.

Councilman Penberthy moved that Mr. Ford be instructed to complete the plans, estimates and specifications for the stadium, so that the Council would be in a better position to decide whether or not it is advisable to construct the stadium at this time. Councilman Hall seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Councilman Penberthy moved and Councilman Hirons seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
