Grand Junction, Colorado

August 20, 1930

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Bear, Glassford, Hall, Hirons, Penberthy, Sievert, and President Rogers. City Attorney Adams was absent. City Clerk Tomlinson and Acting City Manager Burroughs were present.

The minutes of the regular meeting held August 6th were read and approved.

Request to mark highways

Mr. Bart Lynch appeared before the Council and asked that the highways through the City be marked so that tourists could find their way through the City without difficulty. He suggested that the streets should be marked so that tourists would be directed to go through the business section rather than straight through on North Avenue.

City purchase street signs

Councilman Bear moved and Councilman Hall seconded the motion that the City Manager be instructed to purchase signs and establish markings to the highways throughout the City so that the main highways through the City will be plainly marked. Motion carried.

Quinn - change zoning

Several people who filed a petition against the changing of the Joe Quinn property on West Main and West Avenue from Residence "C" District to Business "A" District were present and protested verbally. No further action on the Zoning Ordinance Amendment was taken.

Bids on pipe

Mr. Burroughs, Acting City Manager, announced that he had received bids on a mile of 20" cast iron pipe to replace pipe in the flow line. He requested that the Council decided whether or not they intended to purchase the pipe at this time, before the bids were opened.

After considerable discussion, Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Hirons seconded the motion that the City Manager be instructed to inspect the flow line and make a full report and recommendations to the City Council regarding the necessary replacements, as one of the first items of importance that he undertakes. Motion carried. Prop. Ord. concerning salaries

A proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 426, 443, 455, and 457, entitled 'ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES'" was introduced and read.

Councilman Penberthy moved and Councilman Bear seconded the motion that the proposed ordinance be passed for publication. Motion carried.

The report of Jas. E. Ragan, Auditor, for the period from January 1st to June 30th, 1930, was read. It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Penberthy that the report be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Councilman Bear moved and Councilman Glassford seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn to meet at the call of the President.
