## Grand Junction, Colorado

September 3, 1930

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Bear, Hall, Hirons, Penberthy, Sievert, Glassford, Rogers. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney, Adams, and City Clerk, Tomlinson were present.

The minutes of the regular meeting held August 20th and the regular adjourned meeting held August 23rd, 1930 were read and approved.

Re flow line

City Manager Soderstrum reported that he had been over the flowline and recommended that the City purchase 1800 feet of 20" cast iron pipe, to replace pipe in the flow-line.

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Penberthy seconded the motion that the City Council approve the purchase, by the City Manager, of 1800 feet of 20" Cast Iron Pipe. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Bear, Glassford, Hall, Hirons, Penberthy, Sievert, Rogers. All the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

The Proof of Publication of the ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCES NO. 426, 443, 455, and 457, entitled, 'AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES'", was introduced. It was moved by Councilman Hirons and seconded by Councilman Glassford that the Proof of Publication be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then read, and upon motion of Councilman Bear, and seconded by Councilman Penberthy was ordered up for final passage. Motion carried.

Councilman Hirons thereupon moved, and Councilman Hall seconded the motion that the ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCES NO. 426, 443, 455, and 457 entitled "ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES", be passed and adopted, numbered 471, and published. Upon which motion, the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Bear, Glassford, Hall, Hirons, Sievert, Penberthy, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion of Councilman Glassford, seconded by Councilman Hirons, the

meeting adjourned.
