Grand Junction, Colorado

October 20, 1930

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Bear, Glassford, Hall, Hirons, Penberthy, Sievert, Rogers. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Adams, and City Clerk Tomlinson.

1931 budget consideration

Consideration was given to the proposed 1931 budget.

City Manager Soderstrum stated that he proposed to extend the water main onto the golf course so that grass could be planted on some of the fairways early next Spring, and also to relieve the unemployment situation in the City as much as possible. He stated that it would take about 800 feet of six-inch cast iron pipe to make this extension.

Councilman Penberthy moved and Councilman Glassford seconded the motion that the City Manager be instructed to purchase 800 feet of six-inch cast iron pipe and six hundred feet of twenty-inch cast iron pipe. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Bear, Glassford, Hall, Hirons, Sievert, Penberthy, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

Councilman Hall left the meeting at this time.

The matter of purchasing more twenty-inch pipe at this time was brought up and discussed. Owing to the fact that the price of cast iron pipe is lower at this time than it has been for a number of years, it was considered advisable to purchase as much twenty-inch pipe as the 1930 appropriation would allow. City Manager Soderstrum reported that there would be money enough to purchase approximately 4200 feet of pipe, and also stated that they could store this pipe until it was needed in the flow line.

It was moved by Councilman Glassford and seconded by Councilman Bear that the City Manager be instructed to purchase 4200 feet of 20-inch cast iron pipe. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Bear, Glassford, Hirons, Penberthy, Sievert, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen present voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

Councilman Glassford moved and Councilman Bear seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn, to meet at the call of the President.
