## Grand Junction, Colorado

October 27, 1930

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were Councilmen Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, and Rogers. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Adams, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Budget for 1931

The City Manager presented the proposed budget for the year 1931, which was discussed at length.

Re. unemployment

It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Penberthy that it be the sense of the Council that it would be expedient to form a committee from the Council, including the City Manager, from the Chamber of Commerce, Goodwill Industries, and other bodies, to attempt to remedy the unemployment situation, by calling to the attention of the citizens the matter of employment, and providing some kind of free employment bureau. Motion carried.

Budget accepted

Councilman Penberthy moved and Councilman Glassford seconded the motion that the budget be accepted as read. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

Levy fixed

It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Penberthy that the levy for 1931 be fixed at thirteen and one-half mills (\$.0135) for General Funds and that the City Clerk be instructed to certify this amount to the County Assessor. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting YEA, Penberthy, Glassford, Bear, Hirons, Hall, Sievert, Rogers. Councilmen voting NO - None. All the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

Councilman Hirons moved and Councilman Bear seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn.
