The bond of Lane & Co., plumbers, having been approved as to form by City Attorney Adams was presented. It was moved by Councilman Bear and seconded by Councilman Penberthy that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Bush bond

The bond of W. C. Bush, plumber, having been approved as to form by City Attorney Adams was presented. It was moved by Councilman Penberthy and seconded by Councilman Sievert that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Fuite bond

The bond of John Fuite, plumber, having been approved as to form by City Attorney Adams was presented. It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Glassford that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Re Mun. light plant

Attorney Simon Smith appeared before the Council and stated that he had been delegated by a representative group of business men to appear before the Council, and request that no action be taken on building a Municipal light and power plant at the present time. He stated that, due to the general business depression over the country, these men felt that this would be an inopportune time to take any action along this line. There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion of Councilman Bear, seconded by Councilman Sievert, the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the President. Motion carried.
