

Grand Junction, Colorado

October 21st, 1931

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Bear, Hall, Hirons, Holcombe, Roberts, Sievert, and President Glassford. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney Adams and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

The minutes of the regular meeting held October 7th and the regular adjourned sessions held October 8th and October 12th were read and approved.

Cochran bond

The bond of Robert R. Cochran, garbage collector, having been approved as to form by the City Attorney, was presented. It was moved by Councilman Hirons and seconded by Councilman Sievert that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Kountze Bros. In receiver's hands

City Attorney Adams reported to the Council all of the information he had received on the matter of the insolvency of the firm of Kountze Bros. with whom the City deposits money for the purpose of paying bonds and interest. He reported that the Irving Trust Co. had been appointed Receiver. No action was taken by the Council.

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Sievert seconded the motion that The City Manager be instructed to secure the approval of the City Council before the \$3,000.00 is paid for the 1931 principal on park bonds, which bonds are now held by the City for investment.

Roll was called upon the motion with the following result:

Councilmen voting YEA - Bear, Hall, Hirons, Holcombe, Roberts, Sievert, Glassford.

Councilmen voting NO - None.

All of the Councilmen voting YEA, the President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Holcombe and seconded by Councilman Hirons that the meeting adjourn.
