## Grand Junction, Colorado

## December 4, 1931

Adams go to Denver to collect C.D.'s

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Holcombe seconded the motion that the City Attorney, Mr. E. B. Adams, be authorized and directed to proceed forthwith to Denver, Colorado, and collect the sum due the City of Grand Junction from Sidlo, Simons, Day and Co. amounting to \$10,960.00 together with interest to date, said collection to be made in full by liquidation of the security, held by The First National Bank of Denver, Colo, as escrow holder, under Escrow Agreement No. G-190, or otherwise.

Roll was called upon the motion with the following result:

Councilmen voting AYE - Bear, Hall, Hirons, Holcombe, Roberts, Sievert and Glassford.

Councilmen voting NAY - None.

All of the members of the Council voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

The balance of the meeting was spent in discussing matters pertaining to the mission of Mr. Adams, in going to Denver.

Councilman Holcombe moved and Councilman Hall seconded the motion that the Council adjourn.
