Annual Appropriations Ordinance

An emergency ordinance entitled, "THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1st, 1932, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31st, 1932, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY", was introduced and read.

Levy fixed

It was moved by Councilman Hall and seconded by Councilman Holcombe that the proposed ordinance be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, numbered 488 and published. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting AYE - Bear, Hall, Hirons, Holcombe, Roberts, Sievert, and Glassford. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Sievert and seconded by Councilman Hirons that the levy for 1932 be fixed at thirteen and one-half mills (\$.0135) for General Funds and that the City Clerk be instructed to certify this amount to the County Assessor. Upon which motion the following vote was cast: Councilmen voting AYE - Bear, Hall, Hirons, Holcombe, Sievert, Roberts, and Glassford. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

Councilman Hall moved and Councilman Hirons seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn.
