

Grand Junction, Colorado

January 23, 1932

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, met in regular adjourned session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. City Manager Soderstrum, City Attorney, Adams, and City Clerk Tomlinson were present.

Lowe bond

The bond of P. C. Lowe, having been approved as to form by the City Attorney, was presented. It was moved by Councilman Hirons and seconded by Councilman Hall that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Unfred bond

The bond of Geo. L. Unfred, having been approved as to form by City Attorney Adams, was presented. It was moved by Councilman Hirons and seconded by Councilman Sievert that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Thompson bond

The bond of Henry H. Thompson, plumber, having been approved as to form by the City Attorney, was presented. It was moved by Councilman Bear and seconded by Councilman Hirons that the bond be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Kountze Bros. insolvent

Some discussion concerning the matter of Kountze Bros. insolvents, and the bond of the City Treasurer was taken.

The following resolution was presented:

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Attorney be directed to forthwith institute action on the City Treasurer's bond for the recovery of City funds on deposit with Kountze Bros. of New York, City.

Councilman Holcombe moved and Councilman Bear seconded the motion that the resolution as read, be passed and adopted. Roll was called with the following result:

motion carried.
