

Grand Junction, Colorado

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction, met in regular session at 7:30 o'clock P. M. Those present and answering at roll call were: Councilmen Bear, Hall, Hirons, Holcombe, Roberts, Sievert, and President Glassford.

The minutes of the regular meeting held January 20th and the regular adjourned meeting held January 23rd were read and approved.

Pawn Broker License

Mr. Sedalnick, Manager of L. Cook Sporting Goods Company was present and talked to the Council on the matter of issuing his firm a Pawn Broker's license. No action was taken by the Council at this time.

Improvements and Golf Course

There was considerable discussion on the matter of improvements to the Golf Course during the present year.

Councilman Hirons moved and Councilman Hall seconded the motion that the City Manager be instructed to proceed with planting lawn on fairways 6 and 7, and provided that the Chamber of Commerce Unemployment Committee will furnish the labor for the entire installation, go ahead with Fairway No. 8. Roll was called with the following result; Councilmen voting AYE, Bear, Hall, Hirons, Holcombe, Roberts, Sievert, and Glassford. Councilmen voting NO - None. All of the Councilmen voting AYE, the President declared the motion carried.

The City Manager was also requested to have drawn up, data concerning the golf course, showing the original cost of the land, improvements, and amount of the receipts for the past few years, in order to show that the course is self-supporting. He also was requested to get all possible data on the property east of the golf course, known as the Teller tract.

Councilman Hirons moved and Councilman Holcombe seconded the motion that the meeting adjourn.
